Recent federal policy revisions regarding the places where Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) officials may carry out their activities have resulted in questions and understandable concern among some families in our Mansfield community. We want to take this opportunity to inform you about our procedures and plans for managing these new circumstances.

Rest assured that Mansfield ISD will continue to provide a caring, supportive learning environment for all our students. We value the trust you place in us every day, and we are thankful for the opportunity to educate your children, ensuring they are college, career and life ready.

Current MISD policy addresses interactions with all law enforcement officers and government agents. Our campus administration has been reminded of these procedures.

MISD does not collect or maintain records regarding the immigration status of students. As a result, we are unable to provide this type of information to ICE officials.

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) protects the confidentiality of every student's educational records. MISD will only permit access to student records for those legally entitled to access the information.

This is a developing situation that MISD will continue to monitor, but as always, we are committed to supporting our students, families and staff members in any way we can.
